The supplementary program requires a minimum of ten students for each class. Each hour-long class costs \$10 per student and can be offered in 10, 20, 30 or 40 hour increments. 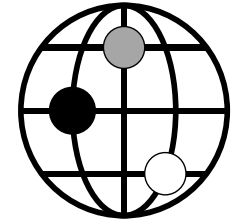
Goals
